CUSHION by Martin Storey

#### YARN Big Wool 5 x 100g balls (photographed in White Hot 001)

### NEEDLES

1 pair 10mm (no 000) (US 15) needles Cable needle

### EXTRAS

1 cushion pad approx. 57 cm (22½ in) square

#### TENSION

9 sts and 12.5 rows to 10 cm measured over st st, 13 sts and 12.5 rows to 10 cm measured over cable patt both using 10mm (US 15) needles.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Cr4R = slip next st onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then P1 from cable needle; <math>Cr4L = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, P1, then K3 from cable needle; Cr5R = slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then P2 from cable needle; Cr5L = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, P2, then K3 from cable needle; C6B = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle.

**MB** = make bobble as folls: (K1, P1, K1) all into next st, turn, P3, turn, K3, turn, P3, turn, sl 1, K2tog, psso.

## FINISHED SIZE

To fit a cushion pad approx. 57 cm (22 $\frac{1}{2}$  in) square.
